## **21. Pure Imagination & 27. Respect**

- Wear sparkly as shown. NEVER IRON OR STEAM TUTU AS IT WILL RUIN. WE RECOMMEND HANGING COSTUME UPSIDE DOWN FOR A FULL TUTU ON RECITAL DAY.
- Pink tights (no runs or holes)
- Pink ballet slippers
- Wear sparkly bow hairpiece worn as pictured; in front of bun and secured with extra bobby pins
- Bring tan tap shoes

## **Starlight Show Girls Hair:**

- Hair slicked back into a “Bun-Maker” bun on the crown of dancer’s head, no bangs. We recommend starting with wet, gelled hair and using the “Bun-Maker,” found at CVS, Walgreens, SallyBeauty, Walmart, etc. It’s the donut-shaped bun-making aid. There are different sizes for different hair lengths and different colors and many videos on YouTube demonstrating how to use the “Bun-maker.”



## **Starlight Show Girls Makeup:**

- Long-lasting Red lipstick stain (PLEASE DO NOT SEND MAKEUP BACKSTAGE WITH YOUR DANCER)
- Lots of pink blush on cheeks
- Black waterproof mascara (optional)
- No Jewelry, no fingernail polish
